8. In your own words, state the author's hypotheses.
9. What is the goal of the research?
10. Explain the instruments and the procedure applied in this investigation.
11. How was manipulation of impermeability checked? Explain and justify whether such check was effective or not.
12. Summarize the findings considering both:
 - a. The effects of perceived personal and group discrimination on self-esteem
 - b. the relation between self-esteem and intergroup permeability perception
